
Immediate Family Relationship Disclosure

In accordance with Minnesota Statutes, Ability Care Partners requires all PCAs to disclose if they are an Immediate Family Member of the Consumer they work for. An Immediate Family Relationship is defined as: spouse, parent, stepparent, child, stepchild, or grandchild of the Consumer.

Exemption of Unemployment Benefits for PCA's of Immediate Family - As of July 1st, 2010, PCAs are no longer eligible for unemployment insurance when working as a PCA of an immediate family member (MN Statutes Ch. 347, art 2, sec 2). As a result, PCAs will not be eligible to receive unemployment benefits for any wages earned as an employee of Ability Care Partners while providing services to an immediate family member, as defined in the above statute. PCAs are responsible to notify ACP if they are going to be a PCA for an immediate family member.
